



Why is Cancer Screening So Important?

Cancer can be treated effectively if it is detected at an early stage

If you don't have health insurance or if your health insurance doesn't pay for cancer screenings, the **Screening for Life program** can provide payment for cancer screening tests for qualified Delaware adults. Covered screening tests may include breast, cervical, lung, colorectal and prostate cancer screenings. Screening for Life registration specialists are available by phone to help you complete the enrollment application in your preferred language.

You may be eligible for the Screening for Life program if you are:

- A Delaware resident
- Age 18 to 64 and not eligible for Medicaid or are age 65 or older and do not qualify for Medicare
- Not eligible for health insurance through the Healthcare Marketplace
- Uninsured or have health insurance that doesn't cover screenings
- Meet income guidelines
