HPV: Improving Vaccination Rates for Health Care Professionals

Delaware's human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccination coverage has continued to lag behind rates of other recommended preteen vaccines. High rates of Tdap and meningitis vaccination demonstrate that preteens are seeing clinicians and getting vaccinated, but they do not always receive the HPV vaccine. During this 60-minute course, you will explore the current impact of HPV infections and cancers, and current HPV vaccination recommendations. You will also learn how to navigate barriers to HPV vaccination and how to utilize current evidence-based strategies to improve HPV vaccination rates.
