**DID YOU KNOW:** Delaware's Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention Act requires that all children be tested for lead at 12 months of age, and again at 24 months of age (DHSS, 2025).<sup>1</sup>

**CURRENT LEAD TESTING RATE:** Delaware's lead testing rates have continued to fall short, with an overall testing rate of **54%** for children under six years of age in 2022 (DHSS, 2023).<sup>2</sup>
