

# Helpful Tips for a Successful COVID-19 Vaccination Campaign

Implementing a vaccination campaign at a dialysis facility requires planning and coordination. Here are some steps you can take:

- 1. Join ESRD Network 3 2023-2024 Vaccination Campaign:
  - a. Post the <u>pledge form</u> in the facility waiting room and staff lounge. A <u>Spanish</u> <u>version</u> of the pledge form is also available.
  - b. Click here to "Join the Protect, Prevent, Vaccinate Campaign" today and pledge to implement activities to educate and promote vaccinations.
- 2. Set Goals:
  - a. CMS goal: Achieve **80% of eligible patients** vaccinated against COVID-19 with Up to Date Vaccine.
  - b. CMS goal: Achieve **95% of eligible staff** vaccinated against COVID-19 with Up to Date Vaccine.
- 3. Designate a vaccination champion to lead the efforts.

### Plan A – Vaccination at the Facility Plan B – Vaccination Outside the Facility

#### Raise awareness:

- ✓ Choose a *positive* and *catchy* vaccination slogan to use.
- ✓ Use bulletin boards, flyers, posters, videos, fact sheets and other educational materials to reinforce the message and address common concerns and misconceptions.
  - ✓ Review talking points and train staff to effectively educate about the vaccine.

#### Offer opportunities for one-on-one discussions to address specific concerns:

- ✓ Utilize motivational interviewing techniques
- ✓ Leverage life goals and what matters most during discussion

#### Plan the vaccination days:

- Consider scheduling on the last day before the patients' long weekend in case any side effect is encountered.
- Consider scheduling on the day before the staff's day off in case any side effect is encountered.

Ensure enough COVID-19 vaccination doses are available.

Provide motivation and incentive.

 Vaccinate staff on the floor where patients can see. Assist in finding COVID-19 vaccination sites in the community:

#### Provide motivation.

 Have vaccinated staff share their experience and what it means for them.



Provide proof of vaccination to patients and staff that received vaccination.

Ask to bring proof of vaccination for documentation.

As patients and staff receive vaccination, provide motivation and incentive.

- ✓ Obtain and record reason for vaccination refusal.
- ✓ Track your vaccination rates and follow up with patients and staff who have not yet been vaccinated to address any of their concerns or questions.

- Batching Organizations
  - Record patient vaccination in the appropriate EMR location as directed by your organization.
  - Record staff vaccination in appropriate applications as directed by your organization.

Review progress toward goal using the ESRD Facility Dashboard in your monthly QAPI meetings. Gather feedback from patients and staff and use this feedback to improve the vaccination campaign.
