TRISH LUNA | AUTHOR, SPEAKER

Todd Davies, PhD, is the Associate Director of Research for the Division of Addiction Sciences at Marshall University's Joan C. Edwards School of Medicine. He has been instrumental in forming a number of community coalitions focused on addiction recovery and has experience in the development and implementation of clinical research trials of various sizes and design: with particular expertise in recruiting patients in Appalachia with substance use disorder.

Healthy. Connections

Healthy Connections is a collaborative coalition of healthcare providers and community resources focusing on the treatment of pregnant and parenting families struggling with substance use disorders. Using a family-centered approach, Healthy Connections has undertaken the challenge of finding solutions to the high rates of substance use disorders and neonatal abstinence syndrome in the Greater Huntington area, and the resulting impact on child development and family stability.
