Delaware First-Time Homebuyer Tax Credit

Delaware offers first-time homebuyers a tax credit that helps lower their federal income tax liability. Those who quality can claim 35% of the annual interest paid on their mortgage (or up to \$2,000 a year) as a special federal tax credit.
