
## PERFORMANCE SCORE CERTIFICATE

The Performance Score Certificate (PSC) is a document provided by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) that informs patients and their families about the facility's clinical performance in the End-Stage Renal Disease Quality Improvement Project (ESRD QIP) for a given payment year. The ESRD QIP is a program used by CMS to decide how much the clinic is paid for the care they give to patients.

The Facility Score is a single number that tells how well the clinic performed in 2018.

Each clinic must print the PSC and post both Spanish and English versions in a place where patients and caregivers can see it for the entire year. The posting deadline was December 15, 2019.
