PERFORMANCE SCORE CERTIFICATE



The Performance Score Certificate (PSC) is a document provided by Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) that informs patients and their families about the facility's clinical performance in the End-Stage Renal Disease Quality Incentive Program (ESRD QIP) for a given payment year. The ESRD QIP is a program used by CMS to decide how much the clinic is paid for the care they give to patients.

The Facility Score is a single number that tells how well the clinic performed in 2023.

Each clinic must print the PSC and post both Spanish and English versions so that patients and caregivers can see it for the entire year.
