## Please alert your care team if:

- You **STARTED** a new medication(s)
- You STOPPED taking a medication(s)
- You have been in the hospital
- You have visited the emergency room or felt like going to the emergency room
- You were seen at an Urgent Care
- You started seeing a specialty doctor
- You have experienced any new symptoms related to your dialysis access such as pain, bleeding, swelling, redness, or drainage
- You had a prolonged bleeding episode such as from a cut, nosebleed, or bleeding gums
- You have a new or non-healing wound, new onset dizziness, nausea, or vomiting
- You need assistance with obtaining your medications or other health related equipment such as oxygen, walker, cane, or other assistive devices

Communication with your healthcare team can help keep you safe and out of the hospital. If you feel like there is something we should know, speak up!
